Aitysh USA Guidelines

Asian World Film Festival is a cross-cultural event organized by Aitysh USA, where participants can share their experience and passion to the betterment of humankind. AWFF is committed to providing an immersive experience that transcends national borders and has established the following guidelines for all team members, partners and sponsors to follow at all AWFF events, including screenings, meetings, parties, receptions panels and forums:

- 1. Be tolerant of all points of view at all times.
- 2. Be courteous at all times, with no disrespectful, unruly or hostile actions or behavior.
- 3. Discrimination or harassment of any sort will not be tolerated.
- 4. Profanity, abusive language or obscene/indecent clothing is prohibited.
- 5. Alcohol beverages should be consumed in a responsible manner.
- 6. Smoking, including the use of electronic cigarettes, is prohibited, except in dedicated smoking areas.
- 7. Guns, weapons, illegal drugs and other hazardous/dangerous materials are expressly prohibited.
- 8. No slogans, quotations, adages, mottos or taglines should be used within any promotional or advertising material unless sanctioned by AWFF.
- 9. Speaking opportunities with audience events, should not exceed the allotted time slots and should refer only to the award/honor or business at hand.
- 10. No prayers or religious worship should take place in public film festival venues or at any AWFF event.

- 11. No video or audio recording is allowed during AWFF screenings and Asian World Industry Forums unless an official filming permit has been issued.
- Safety is paramount. If you feel your safety is at risk, immediately report the situation to the nearest senior AWFF member or Security.
- 13. All applicable federal, state and local laws must be abided by at all screenings and events.
